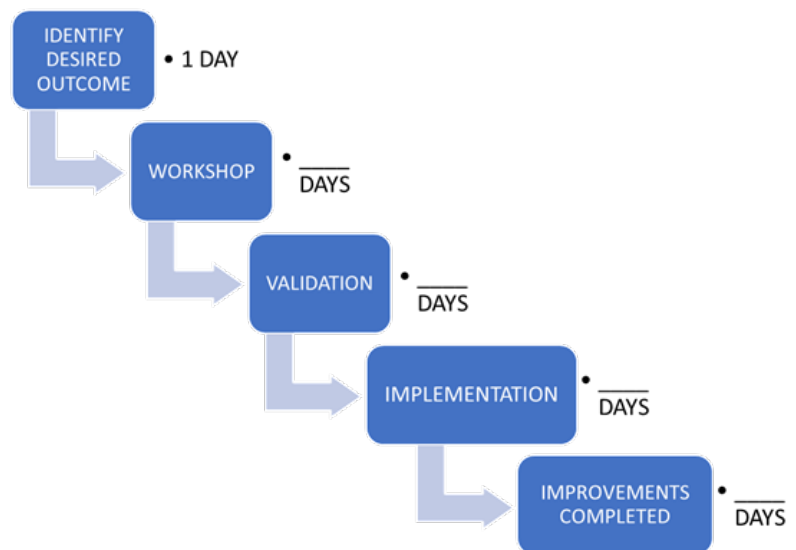


How to Build an Improvement Plan in Real Time
